Policy of student council

The main role of a Student Council as set out in the Education Act is "to promote the interests of the college and the involvement of students in the affairs of the college, in co-operation with the board, parents and teachers". A Student Council will set its own objectives, which will vary from college to college.

Some general objectives could include:

- 1. To enhance communication between students, management, staff and parents.
- 2. To promote an environment conducive to educational and personal development.
- 3. To promote friendship and respect among pupils.
- 4. To support the management and staff in the development of the school.
- 5. To represent the views of the students on matters of general concern to them.

Students council is headed by a president and other council members, nominated by principal and chair person of student council committee. The role of student council members is to promote an environment conducive to educational and personal development, support the management, staff in the development of the college, enhance communication of students with management, staff and represent the views of the students on matters of general concern to them.
